#### What Materials?

Pastor Kevin is the primary writer of the printed materials and the advisor on all streaming productions. Communications volunteers perform these functions:

- Format, edit, and publish printed materials available on a grace basis. This means that there is no cost to the recipient.
- Manage the graphics, sound, visuals, and archiving for our streamed offerings.
- Maintain our website which provides information on the church and the archive location for publications and streamed studies and services.
- Manage the VCC library.

#### For Our Congregation

All of the communications—newsletters, devotionals, booklets, our website, streamed Bible studies and services—are directed first to our congregation. Some, like our weekly newsletter and our prayer list, are designed to keep our congregation informed. Others, like our booklets and devotionals are meant to edify our fellowship. Similarly, our streamed studies and services are meant first for those in our congregation who cannot attend.

But all of our print publications and online offerings are also meant to be used by our congregation in their own personal outreach to others. Refer those who need the Word to sermons or

studies on our website and hand out printed materials. As you *do the work of the ministry*, VCC will provide the materials.
