
COVID UPDATE

You may have heard about the new CDC recommendations this past week regarding the wearing of masks. I have underlined the word recommendation because a number of media outlets reported it as a mandate. It was not given as a mandate, nor does the CDC have the authority to issue one. The following is our response:

- We will again make masks available at the church doors should you wish to wear one. We will also provide bottled water if you prefer to avoid the fountains.
- We will continue to monitor the actual situation here in both Pima County and Arizona, as well as any guidance from State and local governments. If and when needed, we will make additional adjustments.

The Good News

As in the past, VCC is actually ahead of the situation. The CDC clearly states their primary concern is with those who are immunocompromised and the unvaccinated. We have already addressed both of those issues in previous communiques to the congregation. Further, their general guidance is to the population at large and is not addressed to the unique circumstances of our congregation. As we see how things play out, we'll simply keep our eyes on the Lord, seek to avoid division in the fellowship, and exercise common sense in protecting our own health and the health of others in our church family.
