In the next issue of *The Vistoso Voice Weekly*, we begin a series of articles introducing the 11 new members approved by the congregation at the end of last Sunday's service. But today, we answer four questions often asked about VCC membership:

- **Is membership required?** As Pastor Kevin would say, every person who regularly attends VCC is a *de facto* member of our congregation and welcome to participate in all of our services, Bible studies, and activities.
- **What's unique about formal membership?** These are those attenders who desire to publicly align themselves with us and are firmly committed to our mission, vision, and core values. Our Bylaws require this formal membership for some Church offices and voting on business matters.
- **How do I become a member?** The first requirement is that you support VCC's mission, vision, and core values.

- **What else do I need to do?** Pastor Kevin meets with every prospective member to discuss his or her walk of faith and to more fully explain VCC's ministry approach. So, if you would like to consider becoming a VCC member, call the office to make an appointment to meet with Pastor Kevin.

After the preliminary steps are completed, candidates for membership are voted on by the congregation at VCC's quarterly business meetings. Our next business meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, December 8.
