NEW POINT OF NEED MISSION—GILGAL GOSPEL MISSION

India has the largest number of unreached people groups in the world and very few missionaries. VCC has just added the Gilgal Gospel Mission (GGM) in Tamil Nadu, India, to VCC's list of point of need ministries. Through these ministries GGM brings the gospel and eternal hope to untouchables, those at the bottom of the caste system who are the poorest people in India by:

- Planting churches and making disciples.
- Christian children's home for kids when families cannot support them.
- Primary school for 50-70 children who would not otherwise have access to a quality education.
- Indian Theological Seminary to train Indian nationals to share the gospel of Jesus Christ. Sent out in pairs, these missionaries walk from village to village, often standing under trees and talking about Jesus with the locals.
